New Registration Requirements due to Corona Virus

1. Competitors for ALL shows must Pre-enter classes ONLINE @ www.horseshowtime.net

Then search for KDCTA shows OR find direct link on our website www.kdcta.org

Must enter credit card info. Credit cards will not be processed until the day after the show, or pay with cash or check on show day.

2. Must email copy of coggins, signed Waiver for both children and adult competitors and all others planning to enter the show grounds. These additional documents must be sent electronically to KDCTAShows@gmail.com or mailed. Must be received before show day.
See below for specific discipline requirements.
3. Masks should be worn except when mounted.
4. Remember Social Distancing. Please do not congregate in close proximity in the barns/stalls and around the arenas. One to two people at a time in the registration area.
5. Bring your own: chairs, masks, sanitizing supplies, food and drink. No food will be available unless otherwise stated or announced.

4. Dressage rides limited unless enough entries warrant a second judge. All Dressage Rides must be pre-paid. Dressage ride times assigned only upon receipt of payment & forms.
5. **Entries not postmarked by the closing date will have a late fee of \$20 per horse/rider. Scratches after the closing date will incur a \$20 office fee unless verified by a veterinarian.**
6. **DRESSAGE CLOSING DATES:** June 20th Spring Show: Postmarked by June 13, 2020
Sept 13th Fall Show: Postmarked by Sept 7, 2020

****Hunter/Humper****

1. Enter online—Pay online (*NOTE: All online entries must include credit card info)
2. OR At end of show check out, payment may be made with Credit Card (already on file) or check or cash.
3. Changes to classes can be made on show day if they should differ from online pre-registration.
4. Additional guidelines may be established for H/J Show in the fall.

KDCTA RULES AND REGULATIONS

General Rules

1. Registration Booth opens at 8:00AM. All Rings start at 9:00 AM unless otherwise stated.
 2. COGGINS: A copy of a negative Coggins taken within 12 months of the show date is required for each horse entered. If no proof of Coggins, you will be asked to leave the show grounds.
 3. **Dressage Classes must be pre-registered.** Post dated entries, if available, will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Entries for **Hunter/ Jumper ring will be accepted until the previous class begins. If riding both dressage & hunter/ jumper classes, must pre-register all classes.**
 4. The decisions of the judges and show secretary/manager are final. USEF rules will be followed.
 5. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, add or divide classes if conditions warrant.
-
1. AGE: As of January 1st Jr Riders = 18 years & under, Sr. Riders = 19 years and up.
 2. DRESS: Dress will be casual, but suitable boots and an ASTM certified helmet are required for every rider while mounted anywhere on show grounds. Hunter and/or Dressage or Western attire is encouraged but not required. Paddock boots and half chaps are allowed. Full chaps are not acceptable in English classes.
 3. ALL DOGS must be leashed at all times.
 4. STALLIONS: Must be well mannered and pre-registered.
 5. CAMPING/RV's: Must provide vehicle and license plate info upon arrival.

Awards

1. DRESSAGE: All dressage tests will be placed using the Danish System. 1st-6th place based on score.

FOXFIRE MEMORIAL TROPHY: Anyone of any age can sign up. Must be taking at least 2 dressage lessons a month. Ribbon awarded to highest average of 2 or more dressage tests. **Free**-Sign up on line and on entry form.-class #45.
2. HUNTER/JUMPER: 1st-6th place ribbons per class. Divisions will receive Champion and Res. Champion ribbons. Stakes Payback: \$12, \$7, \$5, \$4, \$2, \$1
3. HUNTER DERBY: 1-8 placings. Champion and Res. Champion Ribbons, Prize, Payback: 30%, 22%, 13%, 8%, 6%, 5%, 4%, 3%
4. **NEW!** USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program. See KDCTA website for details.

KDCTA RULES AND REGULATIONS

Stabling and Parking

1. Harmony Horsemanship

STABLING: Stalls must be requested on pre-registration entry form. Limited stalls available, check with manager for availability. \$30 full day, \$15 1/2 day (8am-12pm OR 12pm-4pm.)

PARKING: Trailer parking only in designated areas. No trailers next to barn.

2. Huntingdon Horseman's

STABLING: No Stalls. Must work out of trailer.

PARKING: Anywhere on the grounds.

3. Grange Fairgrounds, Centre Hall

STABLING: \$30 per horse stall / \$30 per tack stall. \$6 Shavings.

Stalls do not need to be stripped before leaving.

PARKING: Trailer Parking only in designated area. No trailers next to the barn except for unloading.

4. Jodon's Stable's

STABLING: No Stalls. Must work out of trailer.

PARKING: In Field.

Fees

1. GROUNDS FEE: \$20 per horse/rider combo on the grounds. KDCTA members & Jr Rider members \$10.

Non-member Jr Riders get a \$5 discount on grounds fee.

2. CLASS FEES:

Dressage: \$25 per test (post entry fee \$20 /horse-rider) Scratches after closing date will incur a \$20 fee

Freestyle: \$25 per test (please have one person pay for all riders and list names on entry form)

Hunter/ Jumpers: \$15 per Class

Paid Schooling & Mini Stirrup: \$10 per class

Hunter Derby: \$35

CPHJC Equitation Challenge: \$15 **FINAL:** \$20

Lead Line & Costume: \$5 per Class

3. REFUNDS & CLASS CANCELLATIONS: In the case where a horse has been entered and not shown in a

Dressage class, fees will be forfeited. Refunds will only be made with a vet certificate minus a \$20 fee.

All returned checks will be charged an additional \$30 fee.

4. CREDIT CARD TRANSACTIONS Convenience fee of 3.25% will be added to total bill. If you bring card on show day and swipe (even though you have pre-registered) the convenience fee will be less.

KDCTA RULES AND REGULATIONS

Specific Rules for Dressage Shows

1. TESTS: Readers are permitted for all tests. USDF 2019 Intro tests and USEF 2019 Training Level and above, 2019 WDAA tests will be used. (Links to TESTS can be found at KDCTA.org) No Horse/Rider combination may enter more than two consecutive dressage levels. Higher level tests may be ridden upon request. All Dressage Classes must be pre-registered/pre-paid. Large & Small arenas.
2. COPIES OF DRESSAGE TESTS are available upon request from the show secretary for \$1 per test or may be printed from the USDF and USEF/USEA, WDAA websites.
3. MUSICAL FREESTYLE & QUADRILLE: May ride test of choice or create your own. Any number of riders allowed. Music must be at the announcer's stand 1 hour prior to class. CD format.
4. RIDE TIMES will be posted on the website 72 hours before the show.
5. **Dressage entries postmarked after closing date will be charged a late fee (\$20) and will be considered only if spots available.**

Specific Rules for Hunter/Jumper Shows

1. ENTRIES: Please make entries at least two (2) classes prior to the class you wish to enter. Please use the Scratch / Add form at the Registration Office.
2. HUNTER/JUMPER DIVISIONS: These divisions will follow the rules and regulations of the CPHJ Circuit. Refer to www.kdcta.org or www.thecphc.com
3. STAKE CLASSES: You must enter all 3 classes in the division to qualify for the stakes class payback. There must be at least 4 entries for payback. ** designates Stakes Class.
4. SCHOOLING over fences is only permitted in warm-up ring or during paid schooling. There will be NO lunging of horses in any rings after 8:30AM.
5. GATE CALL: The show will run with a 2 minute gate. This means the gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring. This WILL BE enforced.
6. HUNTER DERBY, GAMBLER'S CHOICE, EQUITATION FINAL RULES can be found on page 11 and on our website, www.KDCTA.org
7. PAID SCHOOLING ROUNDS will be Course A.

HUNTER DERBY RULES

In the two-round format, the Classic Hunter Round (first round) is judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. In addition, the base score in the Handy Hunter Round (second round) reflects brilliance of pace and handiness. In each round, after the judges' base score is given, one point will be added for each high-option fence jumped up to a maximum of four.

Obstacles are reminiscent of the hunt field and must offer a variety of appearances, such as natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs and natural foliage. The Handy Hunter Round should simulate riding over hunt country and incorporate options such as tight turns, clever options for jump approaches, hand galloping and trotting a fence. Fences are set at 2'3" to 2'6", with four high-option fences set up to 2'9".

The pair with the highest two-round score is declared the class winner. The top eight horse-and-rider combinations ride for ribbons and prize money!

CPHJC ADULT/CHILD EQUITATION CHALLENGE & FINAL

A medal style course of the rider's choice of 2', 2'6", or 3'. The judge may choose to test top riders on the flat after the over fences round is completed. Not a pointed CPHJC class, however one may use this class to qualify for the CPHJC Equitation challenge FINAL, held at the last CPHJC recognized show of the calendar year (which will be the KDCTA Sept. show.) To qualify for the FINAL, a rider must participate in 2 equitation classes during the current calendar year. The FINAL will consist of a medal style course, followed by a test on the flat.

GAMBLER'S CHOICE

Each competitor has 90 seconds to jump any of the obstacles in any direction up to 2 times each. Each obstacle is assigned a value from 10-120 points according to difficulty. Must cross the start and finish lines for time to be counted. Joker Option: once round is finished, competitor has 20 seconds in which to jump the Joker fence. Only one attempt at the Joker is allowed. 200 points are awarded if jumped clean, 200 points deducted if Joker is knocked down.

USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program

KDCTA Dressage shows are included in the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program that will offer regional recognition to USDF Group Members, competing in non-USEF-licensed/non-USDF-recognized competitions. The program will start on December 1, 2019 and run December 1 through November 30 yearly.

Four award divisions, including open, junior/young rider, adult amateur and non-professional will be recognized per region. The open division will offer six levels of recognition (Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth and FEI), with the junior/young rider, adult amateur and non-professional divisions offering an additional seventh level (Introductory).

KDCTA COVID-19 Protocols

Pre-Show

1. All entries and payment must be submitted online or mailed if appropriate.
2. Payments can be processed through the online entry form or via mailed check.
3. Coggins tests and signed waivers should be emailed to KDCTAShows@gmail.com
4. All entries MUST contain Trainer's name.
5. Anyone planning to enter the showgrounds must sign a Waiver/Release Form. (Competitors, trainers, coaches, parents/guardians, volunteers, show officials)
6. All persons planning to enter the showgrounds are responsible for self-monitoring their health for 14-days leading up to the show date. If they come into contact with any COVID+ persons or suspected COVID+ persons or if they exhibit any symptoms, they may not appear at the showgrounds.
7. The schedule will be assigned based on the trainer group to limit contact between parties.

Show Day

1. All competitors, volunteers, officials, etc. must take their temperature, and should only come to the show if it is below 99.5F.
2. All parties must sign the KDCTA liability waiver/release form before they will be allowed to enter the show grounds. Please bring your own pen or an already signed waiver to limit contact points. Better yet, send in with entry.
3. All parties are responsible for supplying their own chairs, masks and sanitizing supplies.
4. Trailers should be parked in the marked spots only. If you have come as a group, you may move between trailers. If you have not come as a group, do not approach other trailers or cars.
5. Upon leaving your trailer/car, unless mounted, all parties should wear a face-covering until returning to their trailer/car.
6. Show Office – Only one to two people at a time are allowed in the registration office.
7. Riders are responsible for arriving at the arena a few minutes prior to their ride times and follow the directions of the Gate Steward.
8. During Warm-up, please make sure you are spacing yourselves out appropriately. This includes trainers as well as support people.
9. Food will not be available on the show grounds unless announced otherwise.
10. Scored Dressage tests and ribbons will be available for pickup at a designated place.
11. Anyone not adhering to protocol will receive a verbal warning from the secretary and if concerns continue will be asked to leave the showgrounds.
